Teacher Initiated Activities: The main portion of your child's morning will focus around weekly theme activities. We follow the Ohio Early Learning Standards that involve your child in developmentally appropriate learning through art, music, stories, and individual and group activities.

Our Program

Bethlehem Family offers a developmentally appropriate program of art, science, dramatic play, music, math, and motor activities. Our goal is to help children:

- Develop emotional control
- Foster self-esteem and confidence
- Increase problem-solving abilities
- Grow in physical health
- Learn self-discipline and control

- Express him/herself in art, music, literature, and movement
- Begin developing social skills, relating to other children and adults
- Discover basic Christian principles through songs, stories, and art
- We are a 2 Star rated program in Step Up To Quality (SUTQ)! SUTQ is a voluntary rating system administered by the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services (ODJFS) and the Ohio Department of Education (ODE) that recognizes and promotes learning and development programs that meet quality benchmarks over and above minimum health and safety licensing standards. The steps are based on national research identifying the program standards that lead to improved outcomes for children. These standards include: low child to staff ratios, smaller group size, higher staff education, on-going specialized training, improved workplace characteristics, and learning standards.

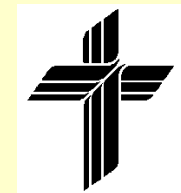
