FIRST READING: 1 Kings 22:14, 19-28

¹⁴ "As the LORD lives," Micaiah answered, "I will say what the LORD tells me." ...

¹⁹ He added, "Then hear what the LORD says. I saw the LORD sitting on his throne, and all the army of heaven was standing near Him on His right and on His left. ²⁰ 'Who will persuade Ahab,' the LORD asked, 'So he will attack and fall at Ramoth in Gilead?' One said one thing, and another said another.

²¹ "Then a spirit stepped forward and stood before the LORD. 'I will persuade him,' he said. ²² "'How?' the LORD asked him." 'I will go out,' he answered, 'and be a lying spirit in the mouth of all the prophets.' "'You will succeed in persuading him,' He said, 'Go and do it.' ²³ "So you see, the LORD has put a lying spirit in the mouth of all these prophets of yours, but the LORD has spoken evil about you."

²⁴ Then Zedekiah, Chenaanah's son, went up to Micaiah and struck him on the cheek. "How did the Lord's Spirit leave me to talk to you?" he asked.

Genesis 6:1-8; Job 1:6; Ephesians 2:1, 2, 12

Genesis 6:1 When the people on earth were getting numerous and they had daughters, ² the sons of God saw how beautiful the daughters of men were, and they married the women they liked best. (Cp. Mat. 22:30.)

³ Then the LORD said: "My spirit will not forever struggle with people for what is right, because they are flesh (Jn. 2:24, 25). But they will still have a hundred and twenty years."

⁴ In those days, as well as later, there were <u>tyrants/giants</u> ("to fall upon, to attack"=violent men) on the earth, when the sons of God had intercourse with the daughters of men and they had children. (Cp. Gen. 1:12.) These were <u>the heroes</u> who were famous in the old days.

⁵ The LORD saw that the people on earth were very wicked and in their hearts were always thinking only evil. ⁶ Then the LORD was sorry He made people on the earth, and He felt sick at heart. ⁷ "I will wipe off the ground the people I created," the LORD said, "people, cattle, creeping things, and birds of the air, because I'm sorry I made them."

⁸ But the LORD was gracious to Noah.

Job 1:6 There was a day when the <u>sons of God</u> came to stand before the LORD, and <u>Satan</u> also came and was among them.

Ephesians 2:1, 2, 12 ¹You also were once dead in your trespasses and sins. ²You led your life in those sins, following the ways of this present world and the ruler who governs the air,.... ¹² <Remember> that at that time you were without Christ, excluded from citizenship in Israel and *aliens/strangers* to the covenants of the promise. You had no hope and were without God in the world [in this terrestrial sphere]. (Cp. Rev. 12:7.)

↑ SACRAMENT OF THE ALTAR (Martin Luther's Third

and Fourth Questions and Answers):

- L: How can bodily eating and drinking do such great things?
- C: Certainly not just eating and drinking do these things, but the words written here: "Given and shed for you for the forgiveness of sins." These words, along with the bodily eating and drinking, are the main thing in the Sacrament. Whoever believes these words has exactly what they say: "forgiveness of sins."
- L: Who receives this sacrament worthily?
- C: Fasting and bodily preparation are certainly fine outward training. But that person is truly worthy and well prepared who has faith in these words: "Given and shed for you for the forgiveness of sins." But anyone who does not believe these words or doubts them is unworthy and unprepared, for the words "for you" require all hearts to believe.

PRAYER FOR RIGHT RECEPTION OF THE LORD'S

SUPPER (LSB Service Builder – adapted):
