## Mark 13:24-37 ESV

## Jesus Is Coming! Are YOU Ready?

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: It's been nearly 2,000 years ago since Jesus said He would return. Since it's been so long, it's easy for us to become complacent; however, each passing day does \*bring us closer and each distressing event does \*point us ahead to the reality of His coming! Therefore, it is essential for each of us to be and remain ready!

- 1. Jesus' Return: As we get into the text, notice that some words describe *ongoing reminders of Jesus'* return, while other words describe *His actual return!* 
  - a. Cataclysmic events: 24 "But in those days, after that tribulation [thus after false Christs, wars, earthquakes, famines, betrayal, and hatred], the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light, 25 and the stars will be falling from heaven, and the powers in the heavens will be shaken. // We know of the ongoing reminders, and may we keep being reminded that Jesus is coming! But now, think about His actual return: Everything in the universe is so orderly because "in [the Son of God] all things hold together" (Col. 1:17 ESV), but, when He comes, "the powers in the heavens will be shaken."
  - b. The appearance of Jesus: <sup>26</sup> And then they will see the Son of Man coming in clouds with great power and glory.

- i. Who will see Him? At least those living on earth. But the Bible says that "every eye will see him, even those who pierced him" (Rev. 1:7 ESV); therefore, when Jesus is coming, He will also raise everyone who has died (John 5:28-29; Acts 24:15b-16)!
- ii. During Jesus' earthly life, He limited His power; when He returns, His power will be unlimited so everyone will obey (Phil. 2)!
- c. The gathering of God's chosen ones: <sup>27</sup> And then he will send out the angels and gather his elect [chosen, predestined ones] from the four winds [NEWS], from the ends of the earth to the ends of heaven." // As people see Jesus coming, so, at the same time, He will send angels to gather all of God's chosen ones; they will be gathered to His right, the others to His left (Matt. 25:31-46). We cannot comprehend the details, but God, in His unlimited power, will do all He has promised!

## 2. Signs Pointing to Jesus' Return:

- a. The fig tree: 28 "From the fig tree learn its lesson [parable]: as soon as its branch becomes tender and puts out its leaves, you know that summer is near. // Those words are an earthly reality that everyone can understand!
- b. The signs: <sup>29</sup> So also, when you see these things taking place [false Christs, wars, earthquakes, famines, betrayal, and hatred], you know that he is near, at the very gates [doors]. // As fig leaves signify the nearness of summer, so the appearance of those various things should remind us that Jesus' return

- is near; He is even ▶at the door and ▶ready to enter at any moment!
- c. These things will continue: Both of the following are \*very bold yet \*very true!
  - i. This generation: <sup>30</sup> Truly, I say to you, this generation will not pass away until all these things take place. // Since a generation is about 25 years, and yet the people living in Jesus' day are no longer living, what did He mean? Lenski wrote that "this generation" refers to "the type of Jews that Jesus contended with" (588). So what about today have many Jews become Christians? Only 2.4% of all Jews believe in Jesus as the Promised Messiah.<sup>1</sup>
  - ii. My words: <sup>31</sup> Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away." // To most people: heaven and earth seem indestructible, while Jesus' words seem like nothing. Nevertheless, heaven and earth WILL pass away, but Jesus' words WILL NOT pass away!

## 3. Being Ready for Jesus' Return:

a. <u>Don't set any dates</u>: <sup>32</sup> "But concerning that day or that hour, no one knows, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father. // Therefore, let us not waste time setting dates; instead, let us – by God's grace – be ever-ready in Christ and urge others in the same!

- b. Pay attention: 33 Be on guard [watch, beware], keep awake [be alert, keep watch]. For you do not know when the time will come. // Being ready is very important, thus the multiple warnings!
  - i. Example: 34 It is like a man going on a journey, when he leaves home and puts his servants in charge, each with his work, and commands the doorkeeper to stay awake [keep watch]. // Jesus has journeyed from earth to heaven with the promise to come again. Right now each person is to do his work, while the doorkeeper maybe the pastor or maybe all of us is to watch!
  - ii. Application: <sup>35</sup> Therefore stay awake [keep watch] -- for you do not know when the master of the house will come, in the evening [6-9], or at midnight [9-12], or when the rooster crows [12-3], or in the morning [3-6] -- <sup>36</sup> lest he come suddenly and find you asleep. // Note that the coming will be at night, thus unexpected!
- c. <u>Summary</u>: <sup>37</sup> And what I say to you I say to all: <u>Stay awake</u> [keep watch]." // Even if only the pastor is being referred to above, the words here surely call EVERYONE to keep trusting in Jesus!

Let Us Pray: Lord Jesus, You have done Your work and now we are doing ours; even while we seek to serve You, keep us ever-trusting in You for eternal life! In Your holy name!
