

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: As a computer can sometimes be repaired through a restart, so the LORD restarted the world through the devastating worldwide flood! From *the first sin until *God called Noah to build the ark was a period of about 1,500 years. The trend was from bad to worse: *ignoring the LORD, *focusing on temporal things, and *having thoughts that were only evil continually. The people of Noah's day were NOT ready to cross the finish line, **BUT** ③the flood came, ③they died, and ③they went to hell. The true story of the worldwide flood is intended to lead sinners to *be sorry and *cry out to the LORD for mercy!

 Promise and Preparation: ¹¹ Now the earth was corrupt in the sight of God, and the earth was filled with violence.... ¹³ Then God said to Noah, "The end of <u>all flesh</u> has come before Me..., I am about to destroy <u>them</u> with the earth. ¹⁴ Make for yourself an ark... ¹⁷ Behold, I, even I am bringing the flood of water upon the earth, to destroy all flesh.... ¹⁸ <u>But</u> I will establish My <u>covenant</u> [agreement] with you; and you shall enter the ark-- you and your sons [Shem, Ham, and Japheth] and your wife, and your sons' wives with you...²⁰ [Regarding birds, animals, and creeping things], **two of every kind will come to you**...²¹ As for you, take for yourself some of all food which is edible, and gather *it* to yourself; and it shall be for food for you and for them." // The plan was so radical, yet Noah believed and obeyed!

- 2. Building and Preaching: Following the LORD's command, Noah made the ark 500 feet long, 83 feet wide, and 50 feet high (see 6:15; cubit = elbow to fingertip, about 20 inches).¹ Quite a HUGE task for *Noah, *his sons, and *possibly some hired help. They worked on the construction of the ark for about 55 to 75 years.² During that time, the Bible says that "Noah... prepared an ark for the salvation of his household, by which he condemned the world" (Heb. 11:7). What does that mean? Noah believed and built; the world disbelieved and mocked. The Bible calls Noah "a preacher of righteousness" (2 Peter 2:5). Why? When the people sinned, he called them to repent and trust in the Messiah! Since they all rejected, they all condemned themselves!
- 3. Entering, Timing, and Water: 7:1 Then the LORD said to Noah, "Enter the ark, you and all your household, for you [singular] alone I have seen to be righteous before Me in this time [thus, believing in the Promised Messiah]....⁴ ...after seven more days, I will send rain on the earth forty days and forty nights..." ¹¹ In the six hundredth year of Noah's life, in the second month, on the seventeenth day of the month, ...all the fountains of the great deep burst open [coming up ↑], and the floodgates of the sky were opened

[falling down ♥]. ¹² The rain fell upon the earth for forty days and forty nights. // Noah alone was righteous in the LORD's sight, yet, in His mercy, the LORD spared the lives of the others and used them to repopulate the earth. Being connected to Noah, they survived the flood, but each person must know Jesus to go to heaven (Ez. 14:12-20)!

- 4. Depth and Death: ¹⁷ ...the water increased and lifted up the ark, so that it rose above the earth.... ¹⁹ ...all the high mountains everywhere under the heavens were covered.... ²¹ All flesh that moved on the earth perished... ²³ ...only Noah was left, together with those that were with him in the ark. ²⁴ The water prevailed [was strong] upon the earth one hundred and fifty days. // The LORD promised the flood; then He sent the flood! How many died? Hard to say, but a possible estimate is four billion (about half the population of today's world).³ Let us always believe the LORD!
- 5. Rest and Dry land: 8:1 But God remembered Noah and all the beasts...; and God caused a wind to pass over the earth, and the water subsided.... ⁴ In the seventh month, on the seventeenth day of the month [5 months after the flood began], the ark rested upon the mountains of Ararat.... ¹⁴ In the second month, on the twenty-seventh day of the month [1 year and 10 days after the flood began], the earth was dry. // Imagine being on the ark: \$40 days of tremendous water; \$then floating for another 110 days; \$then coming to rest on the mountains of Ararat; \$then waiting another 220 days for the water to recede and the ground to dry. It was all very difficult, YET the LORD was ©in control and ©carried them through the worldwide calamity. He will do the same today, so let us trust Him and be at peace!

- 6. Sacrifice and Seasons: ¹⁵ Then God spoke to Noah, saying, ¹⁶ "Go out of the ark…" ¹⁸ So Noah went out, and his sons and his wife and his sons' wives with him. ¹⁹ Every beast, every creeping thing, and every bird… ²⁰ Then Noah built an altar to the LORD… ²¹ …and the LORD said to Himself… "I will never again destroy every living thing, as I have done. ²² While the earth remains, Seedtime and harvest, And cold and heat, And summer and winter, And day and night Shall not cease." // When we have faith, we *see God's blessings and *give Him a portion of what He has given to us. Also, *He controls the weather and seasons!* So, let us ***TRUST THE LORD** and ***LIVE WITHOUT FEAR**!
- 7. The Post-Flood World: 9:1 ...God blessed Noah and his sons and said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth [but they stayed together®]....³ Every moving thing that is alive shall be food for you [earlier they had been given only the plants] ...⁶ Whoever sheds man's blood, By man his blood shall be shed [introducing court justice and capital punishment] ...¹¹ I establish My covenant with you; and all flesh shall never again be cut off by the water of the flood....¹³ I set My bow [rainbow] in the cloud...."

Conclusion<mark>:</mark>

- Truth The LORD caused the worldwide flood!
- Relevance All <u>un</u>repentant ones will go to hell!
- Inspiration The way to heaven is now open <u>thru Jesus</u>!
