Text: Matthew 25:14-30 NAS 1995

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: On Tuesday of Holy Week, a few days before He was crucified, Jesus taught three critical lessons, which are recorded in Matthew 25. ALL THREE ARE MEANT TO HELP PEOPLE SEE WHETHER THEY ARE MEMBERS OF THE KINGDOM OF HEAVEN OR NOT.

- First teaching last week: Parable of the Ten Virgins the wise ones were members; the foolish ones were NOT MEMBERS – and didn't even know it (sleeping)!
- Second teaching today: Parable of the Talents 3 people are each given a large sum of money, the kingdom members acted with trust, the NON-MEMBER acted with distrust!
- Third teaching next week: The Sheep and the Goats all people of all time are grouped into two categories: the ones who acted to help others are members, the ones who did not act for others are NOT MEMBERS!

ACTIONS speak LOUDER than words!

1. Have You Received a Lot? 14 "For [the kingdom of heaven] is just like a man about to go on a journey, who

called his own slaves and entrusted his possessions to them. ¹⁵ To one he gave five talents, to another, two, and to another, one, each according to his own ability; and he went on his journey."

- a. What is a talent? A single talent is worth 20 years of labor. At \$50,000 per year, that is 1 million dollars!
- b. <u>Did each person receive a significant amount?</u>
 Definitely! Five talents = 5 million dollars; two talents = 2 million dollars; and one talent = 1 million dollars!
- c. <u>Have you received a significant amount?</u> The average wage in **1964** was \$2.50/hour (\$5,000/year x 40 years = \$200,000); **now** it is \$29/hour (\$58,000/year x 40 years = \$2.3 million). We have all received a lot!
- 2. What Does Your Handling Say About Your Kingdom Membership Status? ¹⁶ "Immediately the one who had received the five talents went and traded with them, and gained five more talents. ¹⁷ In the same manner the one who had received the two talents gained two more. ¹⁸ But he who received the one talent went away, and dug a hole in the ground and hid his master's money." //
 - a. Our possessions are NOT ours to own, but to manage:
 We →receive them, →manage them, and →leave them behind when we die.
 - b. Everybody is in one of two categories:
 - i. Category 1: We → know Jesus (John 17:3) and
 → manage our possessions according to God's word,
 which points to our kingdom membership.
 - ii. Category 2: We *do not know Jesus and *do whatever we want with our possessions, which shows that we are not kingdom members.

Summary: If your actions are pointing out your non-member status, the answer is **not** to change your giving, *BUT TO REPENT!* Right giving comes from a repentant heart!

- 3. What Will Jesus Say to You When He Returns? ¹⁹ "Now after a long time [during the NT era] the master of those slaves came and settled accounts with them." // These words are pointing to the day of Jesus' return.
 - a. Five You Acted with Trust: ²⁰ "The one who had received the five talents came up and brought five more talents, saying, 'Master, you entrusted five talents to me. See, I have gained five more talents.' ²¹ "His master said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful slave. You were faithful with a few things, I will put you in charge of many things; enter into the joy of your master." // His action pointed to his repentant heart and kingdom membership!
 - b. Two You Acted with Trust: ²² "Also the one who had received the two talents came up and said, 'Master, you entrusted two talents to me. See, I have gained two more talents.' ²³ "His master said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful slave. You were faithful with a few things, I will put you in charge of many things; enter into the joy of your master.'" // His action pointed to his repentant heart and kingdom membership!
 - c. One You Acted with Distrust: ²⁴ "And the one also who had received the one talent came up and said, 'Master, I knew you to be a hard man, reaping where you did not sow and gathering where you scattered no seed. ²⁵ And I was afraid, and went away and hid your talent in the ground. See, you have what is

yours.'" // His <u>INACTION</u> pointed to his UNREPENTANT HEART and LACK OF KINGDOM MEMBERSHIP!

- i. You Are Wicked and Lazy: ²⁶ "But his master answered and said to him, 'You wicked, lazy slave, you knew that I reap where I did not sow and gather where I scattered no seed. ²⁷ Then you ought to have put my money in the bank, and on my arrival I would have received my money back with interest." // Jesus sees every heart: "wicked" and "lazy" point to his unrepentant heart.
- ii. Take What I Gave: ²⁸ "Therefore take away the talent from him, and give it to the one who has the ten talents. ²⁹ For to everyone who has, *more* shall be given, and he will have an abundance; but from the one who does not have, even what he does have shall be taken away." // Those who continue in unrepentance will lose everything forever!
- iii. Punish Him Forever: 30 "Throw out the worthless slave into the outer darkness; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth." // Do not be deceived, this text is NOT about giving but about being repentant. When Jesus returns, it will be too late for anyone to repent!

Let Us Pray: Dear Lord Jesus, You gave everything to open the kingdom of heaven — TYSVM! For those currently repentant, keep them repentant! For the others, *convict them and *save them — so their actions clearly show that they are members of the kingdom of heaven!

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
