# Day 7 - Sat, 12/9 - A Virgin will be Pregnant, God With Us

Read and Think (700 BC): Isaiah 7:14 "Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, a virgin will be with child and bear a son, and she will call His name Immanuel." // When the nation of Judah was being sharply threatened by its enemies – causing great fear, the LORD made two promises. The first was fulfilled around 700 BC – overcoming physical enemies. The second about 700 years later – overcoming spiritual enemies. An angel of the Lord spoke these words to Joseph regarding Mary, his fiancé: "BEHOLD, THE VIRGIN SHALL BE WITH CHILD AND SHALL BEAR A SON, AND THEY SHALL CALL HIS NAME IMMANUEL," which translated means, "GOD WITH US" (Matthew 1:23).

#### **Answer** and **Pray**:

- Think about the promise made through Isaiah... it is completely impossible – a virgin being pregnant, yet it happened just as the angel said! God can do anything AND His promises will always come to fulfillment!
- What are two great reasons we should believe every promise of God in the Bible? (1) God is almighty, so He CAN! (2) God is holy, so He MUST!
- What does the fulfillment of the promise tell us about Jesus? With Him being the Son of God – from God the Father, and the Son of Man – from Mary, He is the most important and most unique Person of all time!
- How does today's content apply to you? Stepping back, I can see God's grand plan to save us \*from Eden to Abram, \*a prophet like Moses, \*David's most important descendant, \*promised through a virgin, and \*born of a virgin. Jesus is certainly GOD WITH US, the One sent from God to take away our sins!

## Day 8 - Sun, 12/10 - Great Light to those in Darkness

Read and Think (700 BC): Isaiah 9:2-3 The people who walk in darkness Will see a great light; Those who live in a dark land, The light will shine on them. You shall multiply the nation, You shall increase their gladness; They will be glad in Your presence As with the gladness of harvest, As men rejoice when they divide the spoil. // Matthew chapter 4 identifies the lands of Zebulun and Naphtali as places where people were sitting in darkness – blind to the truth. Then, Jesus, the GREAT LIGHT OF THE WORLD, did much of His ministry in that place of great darkness!

### **Answer** and **Pray**:

- Imagine being in physical darkness no match, no candle, no flashlight, no electricity, no nothing; you cannot see your hand in front of your face. Then, imagine being in spiritual darkness being ⊃crushed by your sin and ⊃overwhelmed with guilt, yet having no hope for forgiveness and peace ⊙ ⊙ ⊙.
- Then, by the grace of God, great spiritual light shines upon you – freely giving you the precious gifts of forgiveness and peace. How would you express your gladness? It is proper for us to ₱trust in Jesus as our Savior, ₱obey Him as our Lord, and ₱live to God's glory!
- How does today's content apply to you? Many years ago, I was in darkness and didn't even know it, but now, by the Holy Spirit, I have the gift of salvation through faith in Jesus!

## Day 9 - Monday, 12/11 - He will be Born for Us

Read and Think (700 BC): [During the ministry of Isaiah, the northern kingdom of Israel fell to the Assyrians and the southern kingdom of Judah was faltering; however, Isaiah brought great news of the Messiah who would be born in the future:] Isaiah 9:6 For a child will be born to us, a son will be given to us; And the government will rest on His shoulders; And His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace.

#### **Answer** and **Pray**:

 When a child is born, it is born to its parents – my children were born to me, and your children were born to you. But this child, born to other parents, was born **TO US – for our eternal benefit!** The Son of God put on flesh for the eternal benefit of every person of all time!

- Write some brief thoughts about His four compound names:
  - Wonderful Counselor: His advice is always best!
  - Mighty God: He is almighty in power!
  - Eternal Father: Like a father, He provides and protects!
  - Prince of Peace: He made peace between us and God the Father by taking away our sins!
- How does today's content apply to you? If left to myself, I would be ⊗without peace and ⊗without hope and facing ⊗physical death and ⊗eternal punishment. Therefore, I am so thankful for Jesus and God's gift of salvation!

Let Us Pray: Dear Father in heaven, by Your Spirit through Your word, You have shown us the darkness and death of our sin. But then, in Your mercy, You have given us Your only Son: ★entering through a virgin, ★illuminating our darkness, and ★being all we need for forgiveness and eternal life. Keep us knowing Jesus, rejoicing in Him, living for Him, and sharing Him – with anyone who is willing to listen.
