- 6. Bible Book Names and Explanations:
  - a. **OT** <u>Historical Books</u>: Genesis ➡ Esther (4000 BC to 433 BC) – *Basically in chronological order.*
  - b. OT <u>Poetic Books</u>: Job ⇒ Song of Solomon – Fit into the time of the historical books.
  - c. OT <u>Prophetic Books</u>: Isaiah → Malachi Fit into the time of the historical books (5 Major Prophets, 12 Minor Prophets).
  - MT <u>Gospels</u> (Good News): Matthew ⇒ John Jesus' conception, birth, life, suffering, death, resurrection, and ascension.
  - NT <u>Historical Book</u>: Acts 30-year history of the Church (right after Jesus' lived, died, and was raised).
  - f. NT Epistles / Letters: Romans → Jude
    - i. Romans Thessalonians: Written by Paul to Christians living in certain locations.
    - ii. Timothy, Titus, and Philemon: *Written by Paul to certain Christians.*
    - iii. Hebrews: Written to Jewish converts.
    - iv. James, Peter, John, Jude: *Named after their writers.*
  - g. **NT** <u>Prophetic Book</u>: <u>Revelation</u> John describes the entire NT era (from Jesus' saving work to His promised return) and God's ultimate victory over the forces of evil.
- **7. Bible Interpretation:** Using the right method leads to the right interpretation!
  - a. Two Primary Methods:
    - i. Historical Grammatical The Bible \_\_\_\_\_\_ what it \_\_\_\_\_\_.

→GOD tells us the truth!

ii. **Historical Critical** – What does the Bible \_\_\_\_\_ mean?

→ <u>PEOPLE determine</u> the truth!

- b. Historical Grammatical Examples:
  - i. Creation: NIV Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

→ We believe God created!

 ii. Lord's Supper: <sup>NIV</sup> 1 Corinthians 10:16 Is not the <u>cup</u> of thanksgiving for which we give thanks a participation in the <u>blood</u> of Christ? And is not the <u>bread</u> that we break a participation in the <u>body</u> of Christ?

> → We believe <u>wine</u>, <u>blood</u>, <u>bread</u>, and <u>body</u> are received in the Supper!

- c. <u>Scripture Interprets Scripture</u>:
  - To rightly understand a particular teaching (*doctrine*), ALL PASSAGES RELATING TO THAT TEACHING are found in the Bible and understood – *each in its own context.*
  - ii. The *easy-to-understand passages* are used to interpret the *more difficult passages*.
  - iii. Example: Revelation 20:1-6 has five references to a "thousand years." What do they mean?
    - 1. Some use <u>those verses</u> to interpret the rest of the Bible.
    - We, at Bethlehem, use <u>the rest of</u> <u>the Bible</u> to interpret those verses.

## 8. Bible Book Summary:

- a. <u>Genesis Chapters 1 11</u> (covers about 2,000 years and all people):
  - i. \_\_\_\_\_ (chap. 1-2)
  - ii. First Marriage (chap. 2)

- b. <u>Genesis Chapter 12 Acts Chapter 9</u> (covers about 2,000 years and focuses on Abraham's descendants – especially Jesus)

NIV Genesis 12:1-3 "The LORD had said to Abram... I will make you into a great nation... I will make your name great... ...all peoples on earth will be blessed through you."

c. <u>Acts 10 – Revelation 22</u> (covers the time until Jesus returns and focuses on God's call for all people to repent, which includes these five key words: <u>sin</u>, <u>hell</u>, <u>helpless</u>, <u>sorrow</u>, and <u>faith</u>)

## 9. Two Main Messages of the Bible:

- a. <u>Law</u> God commands us <u>what to do</u> and <u>what not to do</u>!
  - i. Can anyone *perfectly* follow God's commands? Y N
    - NIV Ecclesiastes 7:20 There is <u>not a</u> <u>righteous man on earth</u> who does what is right and never sins.
    - NIV Romans 3:10, 20, 23 There is <u>no</u> one righteous, <u>not even one</u>... ...<u>no</u> one will be declared righteous in his sight by observing the law; rather, through the law we become conscious of sin.... ...<u>all</u> <u>have sinned</u> and fall short of the glory of God...
  - ii. Law Summary: SOS → Shows Our
- b. <u>Gospel</u> God's work through Jesus to save us from our sins!
