# The Transforming Power of Scripture Memory!

## **Benefits and Encouragement**

13<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost / 12<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Trinity – 2012 Sunday, August 25→ 8:00 & 10:45 ◆ Monday, August 26→ 7:00

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ, now that we \*know that the Bible is God's Word AND \*benefit from it every day through Daily Devotion, LET US ALSO write key Scripture verses on our hearts by memorizing them!

### 1. Some Great Benefits:

- a. **Transformation:** NAS **Romans 12:2** And do not be conformed to this world, but **be transformed** by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect. //
  - The sinful world, it's trying to fill our minds with anything other than God's Holy Word (see the movie "Captivated" for more information).
  - ii. Some of you may remember the old computer phrase: Garbage in, garbage out.<sup>1</sup> When you <u>put in</u> wrong information, you will <u>get out</u> wrong information. That also describes the work of the devil, the

- sinful world, and our sinful natures: Put garbage in, so that garbage comes out!
- iii. Instead, let us put in <u>God's POWERFUL</u> Word; then reap God's GREAT blessings!

#### b. Guidance:

- i. NAS **Psalm 119:9** How can a young man keep his way pure? By keeping it according to Thy word.... 11 Thy word I have treasured in my heart, That I may not sin against Thee. // An excellent way to treasure key verses is to memorize them; then they will always be with us to bless us and others through us!
- ii. ESV **Psalm 119:105** Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path. //
  - Imagine being ⊗in the woods,
     ⊗after dark, ⊗by yourself,
     ⊗without a cell phone, ⊗near a cliff, ©with only a flashlight! What would you do? *It's obvious!* You would shine the flashlight toward your feet to check your next step AND you would shine the flashlight ahead to make sure your path did not lead you over the cliff!
  - 2. Since life in this sinful world is full of great spiritual danger, God has blessed us with His Holy Word for Daily Devotion AND Scripture Memory, so that we have it with us in every circumstance!

- c. Christian Living: NAS 2 Timothy 3:16 All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness; 17 that the man of God may be adequate [complete, capable, proficient], equipped for every good work. //
  - i. Teaching learning for living.
  - ii. Reproof express disapproval; stop.
  - iii. Correction do it this way; begin.
  - iv. Training in righteousness between now and heaven.

#### 2. Some Real-Life Encouragement:

- a. <u>Dawson Troutman</u> (1906-1956); he founded the Navigators a Christian ministry (1933), which helps people ◆know Jesus Christ and ◆live as disciples of Jesus Christ! A 12 minute audio clip of Dawson Troutman explaining God's use of Scripture Memory in his life...
- b. Your pastor and Scripture Memory in his life:
  - i. NAS Romans 5:6 For while we were still helpless, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly. // But I thought: I'm not helpless! I go to church, work hard, try to be good, etc. Then the Holy Spirit brought this Bible verse to mind:
  - ii. NAS Matthew 5:48 "Therefore you are to be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect." // Then, by God's grace, power, and blessing, He showed me how I was

helpless! Good is NOT good enough; no one's goodness can earn that person a place in heaven. The Bible says:

NAS Romans 3:10 as it is written, "There is none righteous, not even one..."

- iii. Then, immediately upon showing me my helplessness to save myself, God by the Spirit through the Word gave me again the gift of faith to trust in Jesus (the first time was in my baptism into Christ)! The Bible says: NAS 2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man is in Christ, he is a new creature; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come.
- c. Some food for thought: ◆The apostle Paul (a Pharisee), ◆Martin Luther (monk; then priest),
   ◆Dawson Troutman (heard earlier), ◆myself, and
   ◆probably many others when they were adults
   spent time in the Bible BEFORE God opened their eyes to →their own helplessness and →His gift of salvation through Jesus!

Conclusion: Now, → knowing Christ as our Savior – the only way to heaven – and → seeing the power of Scripture memory, let us do it and benefit now and forever! *Amen!*
