OLD TESTAMENT: Genesis 4:1-15 ATT

¹ The man had relations with his wife Eve, and she conceived and had a child by the name of Cain; and she said, "I have gotten a man, the LORD."

² Then she had another child, Abel, Cain's brother. Abel grew up to be the shepherd of a flock, but Cain became a man who worked the ground.

³ After some time Cain brought some products of the ground and made an offering to the LORD. ⁴ And Abel also brought some firstborn animals of his flock, especially some of the fat pieces. The LORD looked kindly at Abel and his offering, ⁵ but He didn't look kindly at

Cain and his offering. Then Cain got very angry and wouldn't look up.

⁶ "Why are you angry," God asked Cain, "and why are you looking down. Isn't it true that if you do right you are accepted? ⁷ But if you don't do right, sin is crouching at your door and wants to get you; but you should control it."

¹⁵ The LORD told him, "No, anyone who kills Cain will be punished seven times." And the LORD put a mark on Cain to keep anyone who met him from killing him.

⁹ His disciples asked Him what this parable meant. ¹⁰ He answered, "You are given the privilege of knowing the secrets of the Kingdom of God, but to the others they are given in parables--with the result that they see and yet do not see, they hear and yet do not understand. ¹¹ "This is what the parable means: The seed is God's word. ¹² The people along the road are those who hear it. Then the devil comes and takes the word out of their hearts to keep them from believing and being saved.

¹³ The people on rocky soil are those who welcome the word with joy as soon as they hear it, but it does not take root in them. They believe for a while, but in time of temptation, they fall away.

¹⁴ In others the seed fell among thorns. They hear <the word>, but as they go along, worries, riches, and pleasures of life choke them, and they do not produce anything good.

But in others the seed fell on good ground. They are the ones who hear the word and keep it in a good and honest heart, and who go on in patient endurance producing good things.

¹⁶ "No one lights a lamp and hides it under a jar or puts it under a bed. No, you put it on a lampstand so that those who come in will see the light. ¹⁷ Everything hidden will be uncovered, and every secret certainly will be known and come to the light.
