Sermon: The Perspective of Joseph!

Based on Matthew 1:18-25 NET

L = Leader ◆ C = Congregation ◆ A = All

Today's service is **Vespers** (Adapted from Lutheran Service Book, 229-234).

- L: Praise to You, O Christ,
- C: Our King who comes to save us.

- L: The Lord be with you.
- C: And also with you.
- L: Let us pray. Father in heaven, the Planner of our salvation, as Joseph went against what seemed right to him in order to live-out His trust in You, so help us to do the same unto Your glory and our benefit; through Jesus Christ, Your Son, our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever.

SCRIPTURE READING and SERMON: The Perspective of Joseph! Matthew 1:18-25 NET

¹⁸ This is how Jesus Christ was born. His mother Mary had been promised to Joseph to be his wife. But before they came together, she was found to be with Child by the Holy Spirit.

¹⁹ Joseph, her husband, was an honorable man and did not want to disgrace her. So he decided to divorce her secretly.

²⁰ After Joseph had thought about it, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, "Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take your wife Mary home with you; for her Child is from the Holy Spirit. ²¹ She will have a son, and you will name Him JESUS, because He will save His people from their sins."

²² All this happened so that what the Lord said through the prophet would be fulfilled:
²³ "Look! The virgin will conceive and have a son, and they will name Him Immanuel," which means "God With Us."

²⁴ When Joseph awoke, he did what the
Lord's angel had commanded. He took his wife
home with him ²⁵ but did not have relations
[sexual relations] with her until she had a son.
And he named Him JESUS.
