## THE HOLY TRINITY

Saturday, 6/6 at 4:00 | Sunday, 6/7 at 9:00

The Holy Trinity – 2020

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: Today is \$the Sunday of the Holy Trinity and \$the beginning of the church year season of Pentecost. Today we focus on the Holy Trinity regarding <u>creation</u> and <u>salvation</u>; during the season we will grow in \$understanding God's Word, \$applying it to our lives, and \$sharing it with others!

Part 1 – Genesis 1:1—2:4a: <u>CREATION</u> – The Father designed, the Son created, and the Holy Spirit inspected!

- Day 1, Sunday Time, Heavens, Earth, and Light: <sup>1</sup>In the beginning [time], God [the Son John 1:3; Colossians 1:16] created the heavens and the earth. <sup>2</sup>The earth was without form and void [empty], and darkness was over the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters. <sup>3</sup>And God said, "Let there be light," and there was light. <sup>4</sup>And God saw that the light was good. And God separated the light from the darkness. <sup>5</sup>God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And <u>there was evening and there was morning [a Hebrew day began in the evening], the first day.</u> // The earth is now in place, but it's surrounded by water!
- 2. Day 2, Monday Sky: <sup>6</sup>And God said, "Let there be an expanse in the midst of the waters, and let it separate the waters from the waters." <sup>7</sup>And God made the expanse and separated the waters that were under the expanse from the waters that were above the expanse. And it was so. <sup>8</sup>And God called the expanse Heaven. And there was evening and there was morning, the second day. // Much water was removed to form the sky!
- 3. <u>Day 3, Tuesday Dry Land, Seas, and Vegetation</u>: <sup>9</sup>And God said, "Let the waters under the heavens be gathered together into one place, and let the dry land appear." And it was so. <sup>10</sup>God called the dry land Earth, and the waters that were gathered together he called Seas. And God saw that it was good. <sup>11</sup>And God said, "Let the earth sprout vegetation, plants yielding seed, and fruit trees bearing

fruit in which is their seed, each according to its <u>kind</u>, on the earth." And it was so. <sup>12</sup>The earth brought forth vegetation, plants yielding seed according to their own <u>kinds</u>, and trees bearing fruit in which is their seed, each according to its <u>kind</u>. And **God** saw that it was good. <sup>13</sup>And there was evening and there was morning, the third day. // On days 4-6, God filled the spaces He created on days 1-3.

- 4. Day 4, Wednesday Sun, Moon, and Stars: <sup>14</sup>And God said, "Let there be lights in the expanse of the heavens to separate the day from the night. And let them be for signs and for seasons, and for days and years [but the "week" was established by God's 6 + 1], <sup>15</sup>and let them be lights in the expanse of the heavens to give light upon the earth." And it was so. <sup>16</sup>And God made the two great lights—the greater light to rule the day and the lesser light to rule the night—and the stars. <sup>17</sup>And God set them in the expanse of the heavens to give light on the earth, <sup>18</sup>to rule over the day and over the night, and to separate the light from the darkness. And God saw that it was good. <sup>19</sup>And there was evening and there was morning, the fourth day. // Sun-daylight (93 mil.); moon-nightlight (400 x sm., cl.); 1 & 4.
- 5. Day 5, Thursday Fish and Birds: <sup>20</sup>And God said, "Let the waters swarm with swarms of living creatures, and let birds fly above the earth across the expanse of the heavens." <sup>21</sup>So God created the great sea creatures and every living creature that moves, with which the waters swarm, according to their kinds, and every winged bird according to its kind. And God saw that it was good. <sup>22</sup>And God blessed them, saying, "Be fruitful and multiply and fill the waters in the seas, and let birds multiply on the earth." <sup>23</sup>And there was evening and there was morning, the fifth day. // 2 & 5 fit together.
- 6. <u>Day 6, Friday Animals and People</u>: <sup>24</sup>And God said, "Let the earth bring forth living creatures according to their <u>kinds</u>—livestock and creeping things and beasts of the earth according to their <u>kinds</u>." And it was so. <sup>25</sup>And God made the beasts of the earth according to their <u>kinds</u> and the livestock according to their <u>kinds</u>, and everything that creeps on the ground according to its <u>kind</u>. And God saw that it was good.

<sup>26</sup>Then **God** said, "Let <u>us</u> [*F*, *S*, *HS*] make man in <u>our</u> image, after <u>our</u> likeness. And let them have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the heavens and over the livestock and over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth." <sup>27</sup>So **God** created man in his own image, in the image of **God** he created him; male and female he created them.

<sup>28</sup>And **God** blessed them. And **God** said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth and subdue it and have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the heavens and over every living thing that moves on the earth." <sup>29</sup>And **God** said [to the people], "Behold, I have given you every plant yielding seed that is on the face of all the earth, and every tree with seed in its fruit. You shall have them for food. <sup>30</sup>And to every beast of the earth and to every bird of the heavens and to everything that creeps on the earth, everything that has the breath of life, I have given every green plant for food." And it was so.

<sup>31</sup>And **God** saw everything that he had made, and behold, it was very good. And there was evening and there was morning, the sixth day. // The F, S, and HS worked together to make a perfect world!

7. Day 7, Saturday – God Rested: <sup>1</sup>Thus the heavens and the earth were finished, and all the host of them. <sup>2</sup>And on the seventh day God finished his work that he had done, and he rested on the seventh day from all his work that he had done. <sup>3</sup>So God blessed the seventh day and made it holy, because on it God rested from all his work that he had done in creation. <sup>4</sup>These are the generations [stories of development] of the heavens and the earth when they were created. // The Spirit moved Moses to write it all down!

## Part 2 – Acts 2:14a, 22–36 ESV: <u>SALVATION</u> – The second-half of Peter's Day of Pentecost sermon; *the focus is on Jesus*!

- 8. <u>Setting</u>: <sup>14</sup>Peter, standing with the eleven, lifted up his voice and addressed them... // In the first-half of Peter's Day of Pentecost sermon, he focused on a prophecy in Joel (see the 5/30 & 31 sermon).
- 9. <u>God and Jesus</u>: <sup>22</sup>"Men of Israel, hear these words: Jesus of Nazareth, a man <u>attested</u> [proven] to you by God [the Father] with mighty works and wonders and signs that God did through him in your midst, as you yourselves know— <sup>23</sup>this Jesus, delivered up according to the definite plan and foreknowledge of God, you crucified and killed by the hands of lawless men. <sup>24</sup>God raised him up, loosing the pangs of death, because it was not possible for him

to be held by it. // God the Father sent His Son, did miracles through Him, knew that He would be killed, and raised Him on the third day!

- 10. <u>God did Not Leave Jesus in His Tomb</u>: <sup>25</sup>For David [speaking a prophecy about Jesus] says concerning [God the Father], "'I saw the Lord always before me, for he is at my right hand that I may not be shaken; <sup>26</sup>therefore my heart was glad, and my tongue rejoiced; my flesh also will dwell in hope. <sup>27</sup>For <u>you</u> [my Father] will not abandon my soul to <u>Hades</u> [the place of the dead], or let your Holy One see corruption.<sup>28</sup>You have made known to me the paths of life; you will make me full of gladness with your presence.' // When Jesus laid down His life, *He knew the Father would not abandon Him*!
- 11. <u>God Raised Jesus from the Dead</u>: <sup>29</sup>"Brothers, I may say to you with confidence about the patriarch David that he both died and was buried, and his tomb is with us to this day. <sup>30</sup>Being therefore a prophet, and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him that he would set one of his descendants on his throne, <sup>31</sup>he foresaw and spoke about the resurrection of the Christ, that he was not abandoned to Hades, nor did his flesh see corruption. <sup>32</sup>This Jesus God raised up, and of that we all are witnesses. <sup>33</sup>Being therefore exalted at the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, he [Jesus] has poured out this that you yourselves are seeing and hearing. // After Jesus ascended, He received the Spirit from the Father; *then Jesus poured out the Holy Spirit upon the believers on the Day of Pentecost!*
- 12. Jesus is at the Right Hand of the Father: <sup>34</sup>For David did not ascend into the heavens, but he [David] himself says, "'<u>The Lord</u> [God the Father] said to my Lord [God the Son], Sit at my right hand, <sup>35</sup>until I make your enemies your footstool.' // The Father exalted Jesus!
- 13. Jesus is the Promised Messiah: <sup>36</sup>Let all the house of Israel therefore know for certain that God has made him both Lord and Christ, this Jesus whom you crucified." // Since Jesus is the one way to heaven, everyone is being called to repent and believe in Him!
