

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: When a person is on the alert, he is PREPARED and PAYING ATTENTION! For example: If a person is on the alert about getting sick, then he is
 the alert, the secretary of the secretar

We don't know if we will get sick or not, BUT WE CERTAINLY KNOW JESUS IS COMING! Therefore, let us be on the alert – thus PREPARED and PAYING ATTENTION! In today's gospel reading, Jesus will inform us and encourage us!

1. The Terror of Jesus' Return: ²⁴ "But in those days, after that <u>tribulation</u>, THE <u>SUN</u> WILL BE DARKENED AND THE <u>MOON</u> WILL NOT GIVE ITS LIGHT, ²⁵ AND THE <u>STARS</u> WILL BE FALLING from heaven, and the powers that are in the heavens will be shaken. ²⁶ Then they will see THE SON OF MAN COMING IN CLOUDS with great power and glory."

- a. <u>Tribulation</u>: Earlier in Mark chapter 13, Jesus spoke about "tribulation," thus trouble and distress. Then He told us what He meant: Some men would falsely claim to be the Christ, wars, earthquakes, and famines would take place, and believers would be hated and betrayed. Those things have been taking place and are continuing to take place today!
- b. <u>Terror</u>: We live in a very orderly world because God made it that way and is keeping it that way! However, just before people see Jesus' coming, the <u>sun and moon</u> normally so bright will stop shining, and the <u>stars</u> normally so fixed will begin falling! If we are alive at that time, we have no need to worry because Jesus is coming to take us home! However, for everyone else, hthey won't understand, they will be terrified, and hthey will have no opportunity to repent!
- 2. The Gathering of the Elect: ²⁷ "And then [Jesus] will send forth the [holy] angels, and will gather together [God's] elect from the four winds, from the farthest end of the earth to the farthest end of heaven." // The Bible makes it clear that God before the creation of the world chose certain ones to be His own (Eph. 1:3-4). Then in time God has been calling and justifying those people (Rom. 8:30). Then on the day of Jesus' coming those people will be gathered and glorified thus given a high status forever, much higher than they deserve pointing to God's great goodness to those who trust in Jesus! When we by God's work and power are continuing in Jesus; then we ♦are ready for Jesus' return and ♦should be excited about Jesus' return!

3. Our Awareness of Jesus' Return:

- a. <u>He is near</u>: ²⁸ "Now learn the parable from the fig tree: when its branch has already become tender and puts forth its leaves, you know that summer is near.
 ²⁹ Even so, you too, when you see these things happening [~men claiming to be the Christ, ~wars, earthquakes, and famines, and ~believers being hated and betrayed], recognize that He is near, <u>right at the door</u>."
 // Jesus' journey has ended, He has arrived, He is right at the door ready to knock! <u>ARE YOU READY</u>?
- b. <u>These things will continue</u>: ³⁰ "Truly I say to you, <u>this generation</u> will not pass away until all these things take place. ³¹ Heaven and earth will pass away, but <u>My words</u> will not pass away." // People ✓ are born, ✓ live, and ✓ die; generations come and generations go. So what is "<u>this generation</u>"? That refers to people who teach and/or live in opposition to ****God, ****God's Word, and ****God's elect. **Bad news**: such people will continue until Jesus returns. However, there is also good news: whenever times are tough for believers, they will have God's Word to ****assure them, ****instruct them, and ****bless them! Let's study, learn, and grow!

4. The Necessity of Being Prepared and Paying Attention:

a. <u>Remain ready</u>: ³² "But of that day or hour no one knows, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but the Father alone. ³³ Take heed [watch], keep on the alert; for you do not know when the appointed time will come. // Yes, God has set or appointed a particular time! The Bible says, in Acts chapter 17, that God "has <u>fixed a day</u> in which He will judge the world in righteousness (v. 31 NAU).

- b. <u>An Example</u>: ³⁴ "It is like a man away on a journey, who upon leaving his house and putting his slaves in charge, assigning to each one his task, also commanded the doorkeeper to stay on the alert.
 ³⁵ Therefore, be on the alert-- for you do not know when the master of the house is coming, whether in the evening, at midnight, or when the rooster crows, or in the morning-- ³⁶ in case he should come suddenly and find you asleep. ³⁷ What I say to you I say to all, 'Be on the alert!'"
 - i. <u>Who is the man who went on a journey</u>? Jesus, *He went to heaven to prepare a place for us!*
 - ii. <u>What did Jesus do before He left</u>? *He assigned a task to each of His followers (Eph. 2:10)!*
 - iii. <u>What are we supposed to be doing now</u>? *Living out God's plan for our lives!*
 - iv. When will Jesus return? At any time!
 - v. <u>When should we be ready</u>? All the time (3rd grade)!
 - vi. <u>How will God keep us ready</u>? As He keeps working by the Spirit through the Word to ⇒keep us repentant (sorry and trusting in Jesus), ⇒keep us focused on God's will, and ⇒keep us reaching out to others with God's love and truth (short-term mission)!

Let Us Pray: Dear Jesus, as some in the world are too busy to I think about You and I be on the alert for Your return, PLEASE Ckeep us alert for Your coming and Cuse us to be an eternal blessing to others!
