

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: *Happy New Year!* Today we begin *⊃the new church year, ⊃the season of Advent,* and *⊃a 7-part Advent sermon series.* 

- 1. The Church Year: There are six seasons:
  - a. <u>Advent</u> Jesus is coming!
  - b. Christmas Jesus is born!
  - c. <u>Epiphany</u> Jesus is God!
  - d. Lent Jesus paid our penalty!
  - e. Easter Jesus is risen!
  - f. Pentecost / Trinity Through Jesus we live!

- 2. Advent:
  - a. <u>Advent</u> means <u>coming</u>, namely, the first and second comings of the Christ!
  - b. Advent is a time to prepare to celebrate Jesus' birth – a time of joy, yet we keep remembering that He was born to die – for our salvation!
  - c. Advent is a penitential season, thus a time to
    *remember our sins*, *be sorry for them*, *turn from them*, and *draw close to Jesus*!
  - d. The color for Advent is blue like the sky; Jesus' second coming will be on the clouds of heaven!
- 7-Part Advent Sermon Series: This year at Bethlehem, the season of Advent will be united with one 7-part sermon series – covering four weekends (Sat and Sun) and three Wednesdays. The series is called: The Child of Promise & Fulfillment. This is a summary:
  - a. <u>Today</u>: **The Price of Adoption** (Galatians 4:4, 5)
  - b. 12/1: The Messengers Are Promised (Malachi 3:1)
  - c. <u>12/4&5</u>: **God Has Prepared Our Ransom** (Luke 1:67-75)
  - d. 12/8: The Sun of Righteousness Is Promised (Malachi 4:1-3)
  - e. <u>12/11&12</u>: Good News: Sinners Can Be Saved (Luke 1:76-79)
  - f. 12/15: God Finally Speaks After a 400-Year Pause (Luke 1:5a, 11-13)
  - g. <u>12/18&19</u>: We are All Traveling, But on What Road? (Matthew. 11:7-11)

## 4. Part 1 – The Price of Adoption:

- a. <u>What is adoption</u>? Adoption is "legally taking another's child and bringing it up as one's own" (Oxford Languages). So, adoption is not only agreeing to provide shelter and food, but adoption is gifting a child with all the rights and privileges of being a full member of your family!
- b. How much does adoption cost? The prices vary; up to \$\$1,000 for an older child from the county, \$\$25,000 for a newborn from a non-profit agency, and \$\$66,000 for an international adoption. In other words, people who choose to adopt are willing to \$pay a significant amount up front and \$commit to a lifetime of love and ongoing expenses.
- c. Our separation from God: Isaiah 59:2 NAS "…your iniquities [sins] have made a separation between you and your God…" We have caused the separation, but we cannot fix the separation. For example, with some door locks, we can walk out and close the door, but we cannot get back in! Furthermore, God cannot simply open the door to us – because doing so would compromise His perfect justice. In other words, our sins *\*are* crimes against God and *\*must be punished*!
- d. <u>God's work to adopt us</u>: Because of God's awesome love for us, *He was willing to pay the GREATEST PRICE to remove the dividing wall and bring us back into His family!* Before creation, *God planned what He would do to adopt us;*then, during the OT era, *God reminded us of His plan;* then, when the time was right, *God*

executed His plan! <u>The Bible says</u>, "...when the time finally came, **God** [the Father] sent out **His Son** to be born of a woman and to be born under law, in order to pay the price to free [redeem] those under law that we might be adopted as [God's] full-fledged sons" (Galatians 4:4-5 NET).

- i. Since we were helpless, God acted!
- ii. Since our debt is so HUGE, only the very Son of God could pay our debt!
- iii. Since we have failed to live without sin, the Son of God put on flesh and lived a sinless life in our place!
- iv. Since our sins deserve eternal punishment, Jesus received our sins and our eternal punishment!
- v. Since the HUGE adoption price has now been paid, God is inviting everyone to *repent*, *believe in Jesus*, and *be* members of His holy family forevermore!

## Conclusion<mark>:</mark>

- <u>Truth</u> Sin separated all people from God.
- <u>Relevance</u> All are helpless to fix the separation.
- Inspiration Jesus paid the full price for our adoption.

Let Us Pray: Dear Father, we were so expensive to adopt, yet You paid the full price through Jesus! Fill us with gratitude and grant us a blessed season of Advent!
