

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: According to a 2017 Pew Research survey in America, Iss people celebrate Christmas as a religious holiday, Iss people say Merry Christmas, Iss people favor religious displays on government property, and Iss people believe Jesus was born of a virgin.¹

So, I'M GLAD YOU ARE WITH US TO CELEBRATE THE CHRIST – the Son of God sent by the Father to *pay our penalty and open the way to heaven!* Tonight, we will focus on the truth about Christmas.

1. Christian Basics: Isaiah 7:10-14

- a. <u>Setting</u>: When Ahaz was the king of Judah (735-715), both Syria and Israel united against Judah. Ahaz and his people were terrified, so the LORD sent Isaiah to tell Ahaz that the efforts of their enemies would fail.
- b. <u>Text</u>: ¹⁰ Then the LORD spoke again to Ahaz, saying, ¹¹ "Ask a sign for yourself from the LORD your God [to prove that your enemies will fail]; make *it* deep as Sheol or high as heaven." ¹² But Ahaz said, "I will not

ask, nor will I test the LORD!" ¹³ Then [Isaiah] said, "Listen now, O house of David! Is it too slight a thing for you to try the patience of men, that you will try the patience of <u>my God</u> as well? ¹⁴ "Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, <u>a virgin will be with child</u> and bear a son, and she will call His name <u>Immanuel</u>.

- c. <u>Comments</u>:
 - i. "<u>my God</u>" The LORD was Isaiah's God, but not the God of Ahaz. Whenever God is our God, we believe His word – even when it seems impossible, and we seek to honor Him – even when it's not popular! You came tonight, I think that is good, but are some of your family members or friends unhappy? Let us always put God first, even when it is difficult.
 - ii. "a virgin will be with child" With God all things are possible! Whatever is going on in each of our lives, God knows everything, and God will help us according to what is best!
 - iii. "Immanuel" That means, God with us! God the Father sent His Son to *put on flesh, *live in our place, *receive our sins and eternal punishment,
 *be raised, *reign now, and *return as planned! It is vital to be ready, thus repentant (S-H-H-S-F)!

2. Love – God to Us and Us to Others: 1 John 4:7-16

- a. <u>Love What is it</u>? •Seeing a need **and** •caring about the person in need **and** •acting to supply that need.
- b. <u>Text</u>: ⁷ <u>Beloved</u> [that is, recipients of God's love in the Christ], let us love one another, for love is from God; and

everyone who loves is born of God and knows God. ⁸ The one who does not love does not know God, for God is love. // When we receive God's love, it shows! ⁹ By this the love of God was manifested [revealed] in us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world so that we might live [spiritually and eternally] through Him. ¹⁰ In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation [sin offering] for our sins. // Our sins have earned a penalty! ¹¹ Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another. ¹² No one has seen God at any time; if we love one another, God abides [continues] in us, and His love is perfected in us [that is, God's love flows through us to others]. ¹³ By this we know that we abide in Him and He in us, because He has given us of His Spirit. // Godly sorrow > faith in J for eternal life > HS > love for others! ¹⁴ [By His Spirit] We have seen and testify that the Father has sent the Son to be the Savior of the world. ¹⁵ Whoever confesses that Jesus is the Son of God, God abides in him, and he in God. ¹⁶ We have come to know and have believed the love which God has for us [that is, we know *•*our sin, *•*God sent His Son, and *•*we have God's forgiveness through Jesus]. God is love, and the one who abides in love abides in God, and God abides in him. By grace through faith in Jesus, we are saved; now, let us abide in Jesus to the end – Bible, prayer, living!

3. Unfolding God's Great Plan: Matthew 1:18-25

a. <u>Joseph's Decision</u>: ¹⁸ Now the birth of Jesus Christ was as follows: when His mother Mary had been <u>betrothed</u> [engaged] to Joseph, before they came together [sexually] Page **3** of **4** she was found to be with child by the Holy Spirit. ¹⁹ And Joseph her <u>husband</u> [since engagement then, was more than it is today], being a <u>righteous man</u> [a believer in the coming Messiah] and not wanting to <u>disgrace her</u> [that is, expose her pregnancy], planned to send her away secretly. // Joseph planned to do the right thing. Think about it...

- b. <u>Angel Intervention</u>: ²⁰ But when he had considered this, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary as your wife; for the Child who has been conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit. ²¹ <u>She</u> [Mary] will bear a Son; and <u>you</u> [Joseph] shall call His name Jesus, for <u>He</u> [Jesus] will save His people from their sins."
- c. <u>Prophecy Fulfilled</u>: ²² Now all this took place to fulfill what was spoken by the Lord through the prophet [Isaiah]: ²³ "BEHOLD, THE VIRGIN SHALL BE WITH CHILD AND SHALL BEAR A SON, AND THEY SHALL CALL HIS NAME IMMANUEL," which translated means, "GOD WITH US."
- d. <u>The Birth of Jesus</u>: ²⁴ And Joseph awoke from his sleep and did as the angel of the Lord commanded him, and took *Mary* as his wife, ²⁵ but kept her a virgin until she gave birth to a Son; and he called His name Jesus. // Our problem – *sin*; God's gift – *forgiveness thru Jesus*!

Let Us Pray: Father in heaven, as we ponder our sin and the horrible eternity we deserve, *let us remain in awe of Your love and forgiveness through Jesus!*
