

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: This is the time of year when the CHURCH YEAR is moving VERY RAPIDLY:


- 12/25/23 We celebrate Jesus' birth!
- 1/6/24 We remember Jesus' visit by the magi!
- 1/7/24 We remember Jesus' baptism!
- 1/14/24 We remember Jesus calling His disciples!

In this sermon, we are focusing on Jesus being visited by the magi. If we step back and think about it, their trip to **find**, **worship**, and **gift** the Baby Jesus was <u>VERY DIFFICULT</u>:

- They left the comfort of their homes!
- They traveled hundreds of miles!
- They were exposed to countless dangers!

Since they **HIGHLY VALUED JESUS**, they were willing to endure all such things! Let us show our **HIGH VALUE OF JESUS** in all we say and do!

 Magi Searched for the Savior: ¹ Now after Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea in <u>the days of Herod the king</u>, <u>magi</u> from the east arrived in Jerusalem, saying, ² "Where is He who has been born King of the Jews? For we <u>saw</u> <u>His star in the east</u> and have come to worship Him."
³ When Herod the king heard *this*, he was <u>troubled</u>, and all Jerusalem with him.



- a. <u>The days of Herod the king</u>: He reigned over Judea from 37 to **4 BC**. Since He sent soldiers to Bethlehem to murder the baby boys *in the winter of 4 BC*, we believe Jesus was born *in the fall of 5 BC*.
- b. <u>Saw His star in the east</u>: The magi came from the east, most likely, *modern-day Iran*, and traveled 800 to 900 miles. It seems likely they saw the star **ON THE DAY** Jesus was born, *then traveled for 3 months to visit Him*.
- <u>Magi</u> (μάγοι): We believe they *read and believed the OT, *recognized the value of the Christ, and *humbled themselves to worship Jesus. *Let us do the same!*
- d. <u>Many were troubled</u>: **Herod** *felt threatened by the Infant King*! **The people** *feared for their lives* – since

Herod had previously murdered many of his subjects under the suspicion they were plotting against him!

- 2. Herod Learned the Birth Location: ⁴ Gathering together all the <u>chief priests</u> [descendants of Levi and high-ranking members of the priesthood] and <u>scribes of the people</u> [men who studied and wrote regarding God's Law], [Herod] inquired of them where the Messiah was to be born. ⁵ They said to him, "In Bethlehem of Judea; for this is what has been written by the prophet [in Micah 5:2]: ⁶ 'AND YOU, BETHLEHEM, LAND OF JUDAH, ARE BY NO MEANS LEAST AMONG THE LEADERS OF JUDAH; FOR OUT OF YOU SHALL COME FORTH A RULER WHO WILL SHEPHERD MY PEOPLE ISRAEL." // As prophesied, so it happened!
- 3. Herod Tried to Deceive the Magi: ⁷ Then Herod secretly called the magi and determined from them <u>the exact</u> time the star appeared [the exact day Jesus was born]. ⁸ And he sent [the magi] to Bethlehem and said, "Go and search carefully for the Child; and when you have found *Him*, report to me, so that I too may come and worship Him." // Even though Herod the Great was "a brutal, ruthless, vindictive and dangerously high-strung tyrant,"¹ he tried to deceive the magi into revealing Jesus' location to him so that he could find Him and murder Him⁽²⁾!
- 4. The LORD Led the Magi to Jesus: ⁹ After hearing the king, they went their way; and the star, which they had seen in the east, went on before them until it came and stood over *the place* where the Child was. ¹⁰ When they saw the star, they rejoiced exceedingly with great joy. //

When the **miraculous** star stopped, *they knew they had arrived at the location of the Baby Jesus* – **GREAT JOY!** <u>Logically</u>, the King of the Jews would be



born in the great city of Jerusalem. <u>Actually</u> – He was born in the little town of Bethlehem, *six miles to the southwest*.

- 5. The Magi Worshipped and Presented Gifts: ¹¹ After coming into the house they saw the Child with Mary His mother; and they fell to the ground and worshiped Him. Then, opening their treasures, they presented to Him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. // Jesus was *about 3 months old and *living in a house in Bethlehem. The magi were important men, but they bowed to worship putting their faces to the ground! Then gold for the King of kings; frankincense for the Priest of priests; and myrrh pointing to Jesus' sacrifice, death, and burial.
- 6. The LORD Guided the Magi Home: ¹² And having been warned by God in a dream not to return to Herod, the magi left for their own country by another way. // God was at work, protecting His Son from Herod until years later, when He would forsake Him to save us!

Let Us Pray: Dear Father, the magi were *not* Jews but, by Your grace, they believed and worshiped. *TY for giving us faith to trust in Jesus*! Help us to VALUE HIM THE MOST!
