Series - Part 22: How to Live as a Christian:

Reach Out to Those Who Are No Longer Functioning as Believers!

James 5:19-20 ESV

Sunday, September 29 at 8:00 & 10:45

Monday, September 30 at 7 PM

19th Sunday After Pentecost / 18th After Trinity – 2013

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: Our current sermon series on the book of James, which began on April 14 and includes 22 parts, concludes today!

1. Some of My Thoughts about This Series:

- a. James, the half-brother of Jesus and the leader of the Church in Jerusalem, wrote with the intent of blessing those who received his letter. In a similar way, my intent with this series was to bless all who heard it!
- b. James wanted to bless his recipients in these ways; my intentions were similar:
 - i. <u>To instruct mature believers</u> *in how to better live for Christ*.
 - ii. <u>To challenge immature believers</u> who were living like the world.
 - iii. <u>To reach out with the saving truth</u> to those who had fallen away.
 - iv. To promote among the community of believers honesty, forgiveness, unity, and love.

- c. The outcome of this series: It seems that ◆some loved it, ◆some hated it, and ◆some ignored it!

 ☑My part is to "preach the word" (2 Tim. 4:2);
 ☑your part is to gladly hear the Word, and
 ☑God's part is to impress His Word upon us so that we benefit now and forever!
- 2. The Final Two Verses of James: ¹⁹ My brothers, if anyone [τις] among you wanders from the truth and someone [τις] brings him back, ²⁰ let him know that whoever brings back a sinner from his wandering [way] will save his soul from death and will cover a multitude of sins. //
 - a. Verses 19-20: They summarize "the entire letter." (LSB, 2145) James wanted everyone to understand this: To be in Christ is to live for Christ thus in agreement with God's Word! Therefore, both then and today, for all who have settled on something less, the Almighty God is calling all such people within this congregation and throughout the entire Christian Church to repent and be blessed now and forever!
 - b. "...wanders from the truth": LTJ wrote: "'Truth' in this context does not mean theoretical [or academic] correctness, but rather the proper 'way' of behaving..." (337) James was NOT writing to say: "You are thinking that way, but now you should begin thinking this way!" Instead, the letter of James is a CALL TO ACTION; a call to BE WHO WE ARE IN CHRIST; a call to FUNCTION AS BIBLE-BELIEVING CHRISTIANS! Therefore, every title in this series has included a challenge to FUNCTION AS BELIEVERS:

- i. **Part 1:** Benefit from Your Trials! (1:1-4) *Remember,* God is at work in your life!
- ii. Part 2: Ask in Faith! (1:5-8) Without doubting!
- iii. Part 3: Properly Boast! (1:9-12) If rich... If poor...
- iv. **Part 4:** Avoid Temptation! (1:13-15) *Leads to sin, death, and eternal separation from God!*
- v. **Part 5:** Be a Living Sacrifice! (1:17-18) Say "no" to yourself and "yes" to God!
- vi. Part 6: Shine the Implanted Word! (1:19-21) Live it!
- vii. Part 7: Be a Doer of the Word! (1:22-27) Just do it!
- viii. Part 8: Don't Play Favorites! (2:1-7) God doesn't!
- ix. **Part 9:** Love Your Neighbor as Yourself! (2:8-13) *How do you love yourself?*
- x. **Part 10:** Be Truthful with God's Word! (2:14-17) *Realize that faith without works is dead!*
- xi. **Part 11:** Don't Separate Your Faith From Your Works! (2:18-24) *Live like Abraham!*
- xii. **Part 12:** Show Your Faith By Your Works! (2:18-20, 25-26) *Live like Rahab!*
- xiii. **Part 13:** Tame Your Tongue! (3:1-12) *It can bless or curse, so bless!*
- xiv. **Part 14:** Practice Heavenly Wisdom! (3:13-18) *Not worldly wisdom!*
- xv. **Part 15:** Avoid These Things! (4:1-6) *God knows best!*
- xvi. Part 16: Practice These Things! (4:7-12) Ditto!
- xvii. **Part 17:** Acknowledge the Lord's Control! (4:13-17) *He is God!*
- xviii. **Part 18:** Be Responsible With Your Wealth! (5:1-6) *Trust and obey!*
- xix. Part 19: Suffer Patiently! (5:7-12) God knows!
- xx. **Part 20:** Talk Plainly and Pray Fittingly! (5:13-15) *God tells us what to do in various situations!*
- xxi. **Part 21:** Confess To and Pray For Each Other! (5:16-18) *Let us be a healthy part of the body of Christ!*

- xxii. **Part 22:** Reach Out to Those Who Are No Longer Functioning as Believers! (5:19-20) *Believers in Jesus live God's Word!*
- c. "...brings back a sinner from his wandering [way]": How can you or I know whether or not a person is wandering away? It's simple! We compare between God's Word and a person's life; those who SAY they trust in Jesus AND faithfully live God's Word are on the path to heaven, while those who SAY they trust in Jesus BUT do not faithfully live God's Word are wandering. Some have already wandered away, some are moving in that direction.
- d. "...will save his soul from death": As your pastor—shepherd, serving under THE SHEPHERD, that is my desire for everyone, FOR YOU: →that you know Jesus as Savior, →that you continue in God's Word, and →that you function as a believer until the LORD takes you to paradise!
- e. "...will cover a multitude of sins": Think about this progression: (1) the sinner is brought back to Jesus, (2) his soul is saved from death, and, going forward, (3) he will desire to say "no" to sin and "yes" to God's will for his life!

Conclusion: The book of James has focused on HOW WE FUNCTION as believers; we do not function in certain ways to get to heaven; instead, having received heaven as God's gift thru Jesus, we now desire to live for Him who lived and died for us! For this life – let us faithfully live God's Word; for the life to come – let us be certain of heaven thru Jesus! **Amen!**
